The SEK Recovery Resources Coalition, supported by HRSA RCORP funds, has made significant strides in providing drug prevention services to school districts, trauma-informed care trainings for agencies, overdose prevention training, and harm reduction supplies to communities in Allen, Bourbon, Coffey, Neosho, Wilson, and Woodson counties.

We have distributed naloxone, safe sex kits, wound care kits, and other supplies, facilitated peer support services, hosted educational sessions, approved scholarships for essential needs, and operated the SEK Recovery House, offering housing and community service opportunities.
